What do we do at camp?

Students will participate in worship services, Bible study, lake front activities, and a ton of fun. Man-made lake activities include the Blob, waterslide, and a beach. Lake Lavon activities include banana boats and canoes.

Other activities: gaga ball, 9 square, Ultimate frisbee, sand volleyballs, disc golf plus volleyball and basketball tournaments.

What does rooming look like?

Rooming is assigned but students will be housed with their grade and gender. Lake Lavon has bunk beds in cabins that fit anywhere from 15-30 in each room. Each cabin has at least two adults. When you sign up, be sure and let us know who you want to room with.

What if my child has medications?

If you have medication you'll need to take during the weekend, please have the medication form ([online here](#)) and their medicine in a zip lock bag at the medication table at check in. Please note, according to state law, all medications (even over-the-counter drugs) need to be turned in and we will administer meds for the week. We will have a nurse that will be in charge of all meds and first aid throughout camp.
